**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR**

**SUBJECT : Approved Qualification Standards for the positions of Broadcast Operations Technician I, II, III**

Pursuant to CSC Resolution No. 96-7578 dated November 21, 1996, the prescribed qualification standards for the positions of Broadcast Operations Technician I, II and III are as follows:

**1. BROADCAST OPERATIONS TECHNICIAN I - SG-09**

**Education :** Completion of two years relevant studies in college; or High School with relevant vocational/trade course

**Experience :** 1 year relevant experience

**Training :** 4 hours of relevant training

**Eligibility :** None required

CSC MC 11, s. 1996 (Category III)

2. **BROADCAST OPERATIONS TECHNICIAN II - SG-11**

Education : Completion of two years relevant studies in college; or High School with relevant vocational/trade course

Experience : 2 years relevant experience

Training : 8 hours of relevant training

Eligibility : Career Service (Subprofessional)  
Equipment Technician  
CSC MC 11, s. 1996 (Category II)

3. **BROADCAST OPERATIONS TECHNICIAN III - SG-13**

Education : Completion of two years relevant studies in college; or High School with relevant vocational/trade course

Experience : 3 years relevant experience

Training : 16 hours of relevant training

Eligibility : Career Service (Subprofessional)  
Equipment Technician  
CSC MC 11, s. 1996 (Category II)
