: École Nationale d' Administration (ENA) International Programs

The École Nationale d' Administration (ENA), French National School for Administration is offering two training courses for foreign public agents and civil servants. Philippine nationals are eligible to the following:

- Long International Course (CIL), 16 months duration (junior civil servants);
 and
- International Advanced Training Course (CIP), 8 months duration (senior civil servants.

The ÉNA is a state administrative establishment which trains top level civil servants for careers in the highest ranks of the French administration, equipping them with the requisite skills in their future responsibilities in the national, European, and international levels.

To qualify for the programs, an applicant must hold a high-ranking civil service post, be fluent in French and English (both oral and written), and hold at least a level 1 Master degree or equivalent course.

Candidates from the Philippines who will be selected to attend these programs are required to have sufficient resources to cover the duration of their stay, estimated to be around 1,300€ per month. Upon compliance with these requirements, the Embassy of France could consider financing a round-trip airfare for the candidate.
