SUBJECT: 2016 Deaf Awareness Week

Presidential Proclamation No. 829, s. 1991 declares the period of November 10-16 of every year as "Deaf Awareness Week (DAW)", under the auspices of the Philippine School for the Deaf (PSD) and the Philippine Institute for the Deaf (PID). The observance of this annual event aims to raise public awareness and consciousness on Deaf persons of their important role in the society and their vital contributions in nation-building.

As observed, people from all walks of life often lack awareness about hearing and hearing loss, thus a National plan and programs for the prevention and rehabilitation of hearing must be developed and established by the government.

All government agencies are encouraged to extend full support by conducting related activities and to display/hang in conspicuous place the event streamer (layout design can be downloaded at http://www.ncda.gov.ph). Attached is a copy of the Calendar of Activities for your reference and guidance.
