SUBJECT: 2020 World Autism Awareness Day

Pursuant to the United Nations General Assembly resolution 62/139, dated 21 January 2008, the World Autism Awareness Day (WAAD) will be observed worldwide on April 2, 2020. This event aims to bring the world's consciousness to autism, a global health crisis.

Autism spectrum disorder (ASD) is a developmental disability that can cause significant social, communication and behavioral challenges. It is characterized by some degree of impaired social behavior, communication and language, and a narrow range of interests and activities that are both unique to the individual and carried out repetitively.

The event would be highlighted through the holding of Light-It-Up Blue (LIUB) ceremony nationwide. To promote public awareness in the observance of the event, all government agencies are enjoined to undertake the following activities:

- · Simultaneous lighting-up in blue of any edifices, landmarks and other related structures on April 2 at exactly 6:00pm;
- Hanging of 2020 WAAD official streamer in conspicuous areas within the office premises (streamer design template can be downloaded at the NCDA website, www.ncda.gov.ph); and,
- Initiate/conduct fitting activities for the celebration.
