MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

TO : ALL HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS, BUREAUS, OFFICES AND AGENCIES OF THE NATIONAL AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS, INCLUDING GOVERNMENT-OWNED AND CONTROLLED CORPORATIONS WITH ORIGINAL CHARTERS AND STATE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES

SUBJECT : Participation in the National Clean Up Program of the Department of Tourism

The Department of Tourism, in its thrust to promote a culture of tourism among the Filipinos, has launched a voluntary national clean-up program involving all Filipino citizens, particularly those in the government service. The program aims to encourage every Filipino to become a part of the national effort to attract more tourists in the Philippines.

Advocating environmental consciousness in the bureaucracy, the Civil Service Commission extends its full support to this laudable undertaking.

Therefore, in line with the Commission's "Spirit of 100 Hours: Alay sa Bayan" volunteerism program, which aims to encourage government officials and employees to render public service through acts of volunteerism, all government offices throughout the country are hereby enjoined to participate in the national clean up program initiated by the Department of Tourism, by embarking on a sustainable clean-up drive/project covering the premises of their respective offices, communities and immediate environs.

You are thus advised to devote at least one day every month wherein all your employees will engage in a clean-up activity of your office's surroundings. You are further advised to set implementing procedures and guidelines to go with appropriate scheduling of your clean-up activity.

Your full support and cooperation are further enjoined.
