

QUALIFICATION STANDARDS

Revised Policies on the Grant of Eligibility under CSC MC No. 11, s. 1996, as amended

Number: <u>1202124</u>

Promulgated: 27 NOV 2012

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission (CSC), under Section 12 (1), Chapter 3, Title I (A), Book V of Executive Order No. 292 (EO 292), is empowered to administer and enforce the constitutional and statutory provisions on the merit system for all levels and ranks in the Civil Service;

WHEREAS, Section 12 (2), Chapter 3 of EO 292 provides that the CSC is empowered to prescribe, amend and enforce rules and regulations for carrying into effect the provisions of the Civil Service Law and other pertinent laws;

WHEREAS, Section 12 (3) and 22 (2) of the same law, mandates the CSC to promulgate policies, standards and guidelines for the Civil Service and adopt plans and programs to promote economical, efficient and effective personnel administration in the government and to approve qualification standards established, administered and maintained by the government agencies:

WHEREAS, CSC MC No. 10, s. 1977 and Resolution No. 435, s. 1980 governed the grant of eligibilities through means other than the regular tests where appointees to positions requiring skills may be granted eligibilities after completing one (1) year of satisfactory service;

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission (CSC) and the National Manpower and Youth Council (NMYC) entered into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) on August 3, 1993 and launched the Skills Certificate Equivalency Program (SCEP) which conferred civil service eligibility to blue-collar workers in the government service whose fitness for the position cannot be gauged by the usual written test but only through a skills performance test administered by an appropriate testing institution;

WHEREAS, CSC MC No. 42, s. 1993 consolidated the positions covered under the CSC MC No. 10, s. 1977 and Resolution No. 435 and classified them under two schemes. Under Scheme I was the list of positions for which passing a skills test given by the then NMYC was required. Under Scheme II was the list of trades and crafts and laborer positions which cannot be measured by skills tests. In this Scheme, the appointee must continuously render satisfactory service during his one-year temporary status in order for him to be issued a permanent appointment.

WHEREAS, pursuant to CSC MC No. 11, s. 1996, as amended by CSC MC 30, s. 1997, four (4) classifications of positions were adopted which require skills not measurable by paper and pencil examination, where Category I includes positions where the required eligibility can be obtained only by passing a skills test administered by the TESDA, Category II includes positions where the required eligibility can be obtained by completing the one (1) year of very satisfactory actual performance, Category III includes positions where no eligibility shall be required, and Category IV which includes positions requiring appropriate licenses;

WHEREAS, since the issuance of the above-cited Memorandum Circulars and Resolution, certain developments such as delisting and modification of training regulations occurred which made it necessary to review the list of positions which require skills not measurable by the usual paper and pencil examination;

WHEREAS, a review of the CSC-NMYC MOA of 1993 shows that some provisions are no longer being observed especially in the collaborative effort in implementing the SCEP;

WHEREAS, in a survey conducted to determine the status of implementation of the SCEP, the Personnel Policies and Standard Office gathered that CSC Regional Offices encounter problems in the issuance of eligibility under CSC MC No. 11, s. 1996 such as delayed submission by TESDA of masterlist of passers of skills trade tests, discrepancy in the data of passers, spurious TESDA-issued certificates, and advertisements made by TESDA accredited institutions that certain National Certificates (NCs) which are not even listed under Category I of MC No. 11, s. 1996 may be converted to CS SubProfessional eligibility and other such irregularities in the issuance of skills certificates by the TESDA;

WHEREAS, through CSC Resolution No. 972473 dated April 14, 1997 Phlebotomist and Senior Phlebotomist positions were categorized under Category II. Considering that the imposition of death penalty was prohibited under Republic Act No. 9346 on June 24, 2006, there no longer exist the need for the Phlebotomist and Senior Phlebotomist positions in the government the duty of which involves the administration of lethal chemical agents to convicts scheduled for execution and other activities relative to execution:

WHEREAS, the foregoing developments validate the need to revise the policies of the Commission for the trades and crafts positions;

WHEREFORE, premises considered, the Commission hereby RESOLVES to adopt the following:

- Deletion of Category I of CSC MC No. 11, s. 1996;
- 2. Delisting of Phlebotomist position from Category II;
- 3. Reclassification of the remaining ten (10) eligibilities from Category I to Category II;
- 4. Those who have been conferred eligibility for the positions which are previously under Category I of MC No. 11, s. 1996, as amended but are now Category II may be appointed as permanent to positions within the functional/occupational grouping without undergoing one (1) year employment under temporary status provided the other requirements are met;

RESOLVED FURTHER that certificates issued by the TESDA for completion of TESDA skills training and/or for passing the TESDA skills tests shall be considered as training qualification for corresponding trades and crafts positions.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, the Commission adopts the attached updated list of positions under Category II (Annex A), Category III (Annex B) and Category IV (Annex C).

All rules, regulations and issuances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

This Resolution shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
