The National University of Singapore (NUS) is inviting senior officials from the Philippine Public Sector to the Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy (LKYSPP) Master in Public Management Program (MPM) scholarships for academic calendar 2011.

The Master in Public Management (MPM) Programme is an exclusive one-year full time programme targeted at senior level executives with over ten years of leadership experience. It was developed for senior managers and policymakers with a proven leadership track-record in public service. Designed to enhance the skills of these accomplished senior officials, who hold key positions within their organizations, the curriculum provides a broad strategic view of issues and an emphasis on management perspectives.


It offers candidates a unique opportunity to spend the first semester studying at the LKY School of Public Policy and the second semester at the John F. Kennedy School of Government (KSG), Harvard University or School of International and Public Affairs (SIPA), Columbia University.

Applicants must meet the eligibility and programme requirements listed in an application booklet which may be downloaded at the NUS website.. Candidates for the scholarship will be assessed by the NUS.

Full scholarships are available to outstanding candidates. The Programme offers one of the most generous scholarships globally with a value of S\$ 130,000 (approximately US\$ 100,000).

Application deadline for intake in January 2011 is on June 30, 2010.
