MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

TO : ALL HEADS OF CONSTITUTIONAL BODIES; DEPARTMENTS, BUREAUS AND AGENCIES OF THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT; GOVERNMENT-OWNED OR CONTROLLED CORPORATIONS WITH ORIGINAL CHARTERS; LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS; AND STATE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES

SUBJECT : Amendment of the Qualification Standards for the Respiratory Therapist I, II, and III Positions

Pursuant to **CSC Resolution No. 2000290** promulgated on 11 February 2020, the Commission resolved to approve the amendment of the minimum qualification standards for the Respiratory Therapist positions, as follows:

Position Title	Education	Experience	Training	Eligibility
Respiratory Therapist I (SG-11)	Bachelor of Science in Respiratory Therapy	None Required	None required	RA 1080 (Respiratory Therapist)
Respiratory Therapist II (SG-14)	Bachelor of Science in Respiratory Therapy	1 year of relevant experience	4 hours of relevant training	RA 1080 (Respiratory Therapist)
Respiratory Therapist III (SG-17)	Bachelor of Science in Respiratory Therapy	2 years of relevant experience	8 hours of relevant training	RA 1080 (Respiratory Therapist)

The incumbents of Respiratory Therapist positions who do not possess RA 1080 (Respiratory Therapist) eligibility but were appointed under permanent status before December 18, 2013 shall no longer be disturbed. However, they cannot be promoted to higher Respiratory Therapist positions unless they possess the required RA 1080 (Respiratory Therapist) eligibility.

The above qualification standards shall be the bases of the Civil Service Commission in attesting appointments and in evaluating other human resource actions for the subject positions.

CSC Resolution No. 2000290 shall take effect on October 18, 2020 or after fifteen (15) days from its publication in The Philippine Star on October 2, 2020.
