SUBJECT : 2021 Young Leader's Program

The Japan Information and Culture Center (JICC), Embassy of Japan is pleased to announce that the application for the **2021 Young Leader's Program (YLP)** is now open.

The YLP is an academic scholarship program funded by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT) of Japan. It aims to prepare young professionals from different countries for future leadership roles in their respective fields by enabling them to pursue graduate level study in select Japanese universities.

YLP grantees may choose to specialize in any of the following areas of study: (1) Business Administration, (2) Law, (3) School of Government – Public Administration, and (4) Local Governance. The one-year duration of this program is set to commence around September - October 2021 and classes will be conducted primarily in English. A master's degree will be conferred to participants upon successful completion of the program.
