Moral and Spiritual Guidance Week

The National Social Action Council (NASAC) is a tri-sectoral foundation composed of government, private, and religious groups created under Executive Order No. 182-A as amended by Presidential Decree No. 294. Further, under Presidential Proclamation No. 472 dated October 2, 1989, then President Corazon C. Aquino declared the second week of October, as the "Moral and Spiritual" Guidance (MSG) Week for Public Servants".

The NASAC shall lead the nationwide annual celebration of the Moral and Spiritual Guidance (MSG) Week which will be observed on October 21-27, 2012 with the theme: "NASAC and the CHALLENGES OF THE TIMES". All branches of the government are encouraged to participate for its successful celebration.
