### MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

**TO :** ALL HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS, BUREAUS AND AGENCIES OF THE NATIONAL AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS, STATE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES, INCLUDING GOVERNMENT-OWNED OR CONTROLLED CORPORATIONS WITH ORIGINAL CHARTERS

**SUBJECT :** Conduct of the Meat Inspection and Safety Examination and Grant of the Meat Inspector Eligibility

Pursuant to CSC Resolution No. 1300932 promulgated on May 17, 2013, the Commission has resolved, as follows:

1. Conduct, in collaboration with the National Meat Inspection Service (NMIS) through a Memorandum of Agreement, a specialized examination which shall be known as the Meat Inspection and Safety Examination starting this year (2013);

The Meat Inspection and Safety Examination (MISE) shall be open to all meat inspectors and all individuals who are interested to join the meat inspection service provided, they have not yet been granted any second level eligibility appropriate for the positions under said service.

Applicants to the MISE, except those who are incumbents of Meat Inspector positions, must have completed at least 72 units leading to a bachelor/baccalaureate degree, subject to presentation of Scholastic Record or official Transcript of Record issued and authenticated by the registrar or authorized official of the school concerned.

2. Require applicants to pay an examination fee of Php500.00 upon filing of application; the fee for the succeeding years to be approved by the Commission based on the cost of conducting the examination;
3. Grant to those who will pass the MISE, based on test standards set by the Commission, the Meat Inspector Eligibility, which shall be appropriate for appointment to first and second level positions in the meat inspection and allied/functionally related services, subject to meeting all the qualification requirements of the positions; and

4. Based on the request by the NMIS, conduct again the MISE until such time that a PRC prescribed examination professionalizing the meat inspection service has been established.”

CSC Resolution No. 1300932, promulgated on May 17, 2013, was published in The Manila Times on November 7, 2014.
